GOOD FRIDAY & EASTER MONDAY

Friday, April 2nd, is Good Friday and therefore the school will be closed.

The school is also closed on Easter Monday, April 5th.

The three holiest days of the year begin at sundown on Holy Thursday and last until sundown on Easter Sunday. This time is known as the Paschal Triduum. "Paschal" means "of or pertaining to Easter" and "Triduum" is a Latin word meaning "three days".
