VOLUNTEER POSITIONS AVAILABLE - PSG (Parent Support Group)

The PSG consists of five members: three Executives (Chair, Secretary and Treasurer) and two Members at Large. Members are elected to the PSG and then positions are assigned. Only these five positions are eligible for parent participation hours.

The mandate of the Parent Support Group is to administer, report and apply for gaming funds from the BC Provincial Government. This includes the per student Direct Access Grant. The PSG is responsible for all reporting and accounting on these funds, in accordance with gaming regulations. The team discusses and plans future projects/activities for the funds received.

To be eligible for a position, you must be a parent of a child currently enrolled at St. Michael's Elementary School. PSG members must be independent of the school authority. Therefore, candidates for election must NOT be a member of the school staff, administration or any governing body of the school.
