## Dear Parents,

We are located on a busy street and have very limited space for cars in our main parking lot. This makes it particularly important that we continue to follow the traffic safety rules and traffic directions we have in place for pick up and drop off. Please take careful note of the following:

## When Parking

- Drive slowly and carefully to keep our children safe
- Park only in designated spots and ensure you stay within the boundaries of the spot.
  - Never stop or park in our fire lane (highlighted with yellow paint)
- Escort children to and from the playground area using ONLY the designated crossing points (yellow crosswalk by the swings or at the top point of the drive through lane)

## When using the morning drive through lane

- Drive slowly and carefully to keep our children safe
  - Pay close attention to your surroundings
  - Stay within the boundaries of the cones
- Drop off only at the top of the lane before you turn right to exit

We greatly appreciate your attention to this important matter. By exercising patience and diligence, we can ensure the safety of all of our families.

- 2. Register for an account by clicking the "**REGISTER**" menu tab and filling in the on-line form. Choose a user id and password for yourself and then click the "**Register Now**" button.
- 3. Add your children into the system by clicking the "Add a Student" button. If you have more than one child, click "Insert New" to add siblings.
- 4. Click the "date" icon beside each child's name to schedule appointments. Select the teacher you wish to book appointments with and the "View Calendars" button.
- 5. Click on available time slots to book your appointments and then click the "**Book Appointments**" button to save your bookings. Repeat for each child.
- 6. Print your schedule of appointments when you have completed booking all your appointments.
- 7. When you have completed your entries click to "LOG OUT"
